### CALL YOUR PA REPRESENTATIVE



While he/she is at home until November 12, we urge you to call your PA representative and **strongly suggest** that she/he co-sponsor the bill that will be introduced by Rep. Bryan Cutler from District 100 in Lancaster. Previously HB 1314, **it will get**

**a new number when it is introduced** for the 2013-2014 session. It will protect the rights of women and unborn children from events such as those disclosed at the facility run by Kermit Gosnell. (see p.3 for good news at this location).

When signed by Gov. Corbett, the law will provide that "any physician performing or inducing and abortion who does not have clinical privileges at a hospital which offers obstetrical or gynecological care located within 30 miles of the location at which the abortion is performed or induced shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor in the third degree."

## ANDREA BOCELLI



Andrea Bocelli, opera singer *extraordinaire*, interrupted a concert to recount the story of a pregnant woman who was admitted to the hospital with appendicitis. “The doctors had to apply some ice on her stomach and when the treatments ended, the doctors suggested that she abort the child,” said the singer. “They told her it was the best solution because the baby would be born with some disability. But the young brave wife decided not to abort, and the child was born,” he said. “That woman was my mother, and I was the child.” He added: “Maybe I’m partisan, but I can say that it was the right choice, and I hope that this could encourage many mothers who sometimes might find themselves in difficulty, but want to save the life of their baby.”

## PRAY FOR IRELAND



The coalition government’s proposed legislation, the Protection of Life during Pregnancy Bill 2013, would legalize direct abortion. The Irish people are fighting hard to protect their women and children from abortion. A change in the law would allow the death of Irish children in the womb, for any reason at any time.

## OPPOSE PILLARD NOMINATION



We urge YOU to call both Senator Casey (1-866-802-2833) and Senator Toomey (1-855-552-1831). Both numbers = toll free. Urge your U.S. Senators to vote against all motions advancing the confirmation of radical law professor Cornelia Pillard to the bench of the U.S. District Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia.

A law professor at Georgetown University, Pillard argues that abortion is necessary to help “free women from historically routine *conscriptio*n into maternity.” She takes the opportunity in her writings to slam anyone who opposes the abortion-contraceptive mandate as “reinforce[ing] broader patterns of discrimination against women as a class of *presumptive breeders*.” Pillard’s views suggest that “technology is somehow manipulating Americans to consider the personhood of the unborn.” She criticizes ultrasound because she believes it manufactures “deceptive images of fetus-as-autonomous-being that the anti-choice movement has popularized since the advent of amniocentesis.” *Source: T.Perkins- LifeNews.com, 7-13.*

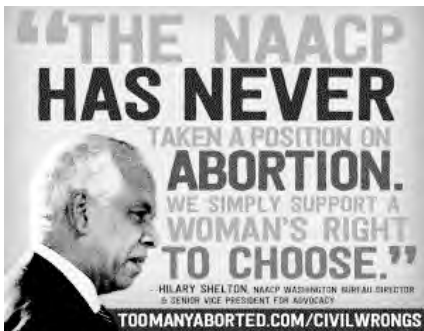

## PA REP. METCALFE TO INTRODUCE "WHOLE WOMAN'S HEALTH FUNDING PRIORITIES ACT"



In the near future, Rep. Darryl Metcalfe intends to reintroduce legislation that will direct the Department of Health as to how it must prioritize the allocation of public funds for family planning purposes.

Limited federal and state public funding exists for family planning and preventive health services for women. Metcalfe's legislation would assure citizens that their tax dollars are going to the most efficient point-of-service health care providers.

Public entities, non-public hospitals and federally qualified health centers, rural health clinics and non-public health providers that have their primary purpose as the provision of primary health care would come first.

The legislation will prohibit the Department of Health from entering into any contract with or providing grants to any entity that performs non-federally qualified abortions. This legislation would improve the quality of health care for women and would not reduce the level of public funding allocated for women's health services.

**ACTION:** Call YOUR state representative. If you are not sure who he/she is, call PCUC, and we will get that number for you. Your message: "Please co-sponsor the Whole Woman's Health Funding Priorities Act."

## DEATH WITH DIGNITY? SAYS WHO?

In June, two strongly pro-abortion PA Senators, Jim FERLO and Daylin LEACH introduced Senate Bill No. 1032, labeled DEATH WITH DIGNITY. The Act goes on for 19 pages of regulations, qualifications, definitions, opinions, requirements, reservations, medications and, of course, *protections*. You can read the document on the PA Senate site, but for a more comprehensive lesson, we suggest that you go to [www.PatientsRightsCouncil.org](http://www.PatientsRightsCouncil.org). There you will find useful information on the abuses and problems in states where doctor-prescribed suicide is legal.

There are two important things to remember as we read media reports on "death with dignity" cases, (1) depending on who writes and edits the story, the story will favor life or death and (2) as we fall deeper in the hole of socialized medicine, there will be more progress toward the cheaper, rather than the highest quality care.
