#### LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear PCUC Family,

Recently I was attending mass (not my home parish), where the priest was praising the life and contributions of Nelson Mandela, comparing him to Martin Luther King and Ghandi and stopping very short of giving him equal status to Jesus. Yet, in 1996 Nelson Mandela promoted and signed into law the "Choice on Termination of Pregnancy Bill" that replaced one of the world's toughest abortion laws with one of the most liberal. Nelson Mandela *used* his popularity, and like so many other politicians, *used* his office to promote the slaughter of unborn babies. What about the civil and human rights of the African babies?

While the world is lamenting his death and honoring his life, I will lament the precious lives lost because of the swipe of his pen. In time, Mandela will be lost in the history books but his real legacy, which is the untold deaths of his countrymen, will live on

According to the Guttmacher Institute, 13% of all pregnancies in Africa end in abortion. This translates into 6.4 million babies who die annually in the African death mills. The World Health Organization estimates that in Africa 1.7 million women are hospitalized annually for complications of unsafe abortions

I prefer the legacy of Jesus, our true Savior, as told by a pastor to a group of young people: "A child was born and lived in obscure villages, and then for three brief years as a preacher. He never wrote a book. He never held an office. He never raised an army. He gathered a little group of friends about him and taught them his way of life. While still a young man, the tide of popular feeling turned against him.

"He was betrayed, tortured and killed and laid in a borrowed grave.

"Twenty centuries have come and gone, and today Jesus is the central figure of the human race, and the leader of mankind's progress. All the armies that have ever marched; all the navies that have ever sailed; all the parliaments that have ever sat; all the kings that ever reigned put together, have not affected the life of mankind on earth, as powerfully as this **one solitary life.**"

As our world tries to take Jesus away from us, let us pray for strength to battle the forces of evil and be emboldened with love, charity and joy. Let us pray, too, for the repose of the soul of Nelson Mandela, that our God, who is always merciful and forgiving, will bring His beloved son into the light of heaven.

During this holy season of Christmas let us together embrace The Holy Family and ask our Lord and Savior to send us leaders of moral conviction.

#### LOOK FOR ACTION IN HARRISBURG



We must never stop talking to our state senators and representatives. We must know that pro-abortion lobbyists are at the Capitol early and often, and while we have nothing personal to gain when pro-life laws are enacted,

those who work in the abortion industry are fighting to keep their jobs, nasty and grisly as they are.

As we begin the new year, let us look for opportunities to urge our lawmakers to (1) protect young women from child molesters by insisting that abortion mills tell the truth about the age of their clients and the age of the father of the baby. (2) demand that abortionists have hospital privileges at hospitals within 30 miles of the facility where they

#### WILL WE LEARN THE TRUTH ABOUT PP?

The Non-Profit Times reported in September that at the request of 72 members of Congress, the Government Accountability Office (GAO) intends to investigate the use of federal money by Planned Parenthood of America (PPFA), based in New York City, and other family planning nonprofits.

Rep. Diane Black (TN), Rep. Peter Olson (TX) and Sen. David Vitter (LA) sent a letter to U.S. Comptroller General Gene Dodaro requesting an investigation into PPFA, The Population Council, The Guttmacher Institute, Advocates for Youth and Sexuality Information and Education Council of the United States (SIECUS).

Chuck Young from the GAO's Office of Public Affairs said that his office accepted the request of the members of Congress. At PP, Eric Ferraro, PPFA Director of Public Affairs, charged that the report would be routine. "This is just another attempt by opponents of women's health care to attack women's access to PP's preventive health services..."

Meanwhile, there is disagreement as to what portion of PP's business is abortion.

Students for Life of America keeps a close eye on PP. Although PP says that "only" 3 percent of their services are abortion. While the 3 percent number is technically correct, counting the number of services is not a good metric. On page 14 of PP's annual report, in the fine print with 6 asterisks, PP states that it served approximately 3 million people. With a reported 327,166 abortions, that means that *at minimum* more than 1 in 10—11 percent of PEOPLE—(both men and women) who walk into a PP get an abortion. Call us for both articles. [Editor]

(from column 1) perform abortions. This will end the dance of death by "circuit riders" who move from city to city as they are called. We may not be able to stop abortion, but we can slow its progress.

(3) the PA Department of Health must have the credentials of every abortionist in the state. They cannot allow men and women who are no longer licensed to practice to have the lives of gullible women and innocent babies in their hands.

The laws that were signed last November by Governor Corbett put many PA abortion mills out of practice, but abortion is still the most unregulated surgery in the U.S. The U.S. Supreme Court made a terrible mistake in 1973. It has taken us 40 years to get this far. Let us not let ANYTHING STOP US. The future of our country depends on us.

#### LIES, LIES AND MORE LIES

That's the only way to accurately describe the way that the Obama Administration has handled the issue of abortion funding in Obamacare.

The latest lie came when HHS Secretary Kathleen Sebelius claimed that if consumers wanted to know which plans cover abortion under Obamacare, all they had to do was check the summary and benefits section of each plan on Healthcare.gov.

She said this after promising over a month ago to the same House panel that she would provide them with a list of plans that do not cover abortion.

HHS Secretary Kathleen Sebelius didn't keep her promise. Pro-life Members of Congress have had enough of Kathleen Sebelius's lies. Thus, Rep. Chris Smith (NJ) and Sen. Pat Roberts (KS) have introduced the "Abortion Insurance Full Disclosure Act."

Take Action: Tell your U.S. Representative and two Senators to pass the Abortion Insurance Full Disclosure Act immediately. This legislation does two simple things:

- Requires the Obamacare exchanges to prominently disclose if an insurance plan covers abortions

#### GAME CHANGING STUDY ON A-BC



Dr. Mary Davenport, an ob-gyn who practices in California, reported to American Thinker about a shocking study out of China that confirms the link between abortion and breast cancer.

The new study, pooling 36 studies from 14 provinces in China, showed that abortion increased the risk of breast cancer by 44% with one abortion, and 76% and 89% with two and three abortions, respectively.

When you factor in that half of abortions in the U.S. are repeat abortions, that means that well over half a million women each year are exposing themselves to an incredible risk for breast cancer.

Each year Planned Parenthood brings in \$173,000,000 performing abortions.

Put your return address on the card (but not on a sticker) as well as on the outside of the envelope. Do not discuss the internal workings of the prison. Do not include anything confidential, as prison guards scrutinize all incoming mail. Finally, keep Mary in your prayers. We know you will. #### **VIGILANCE PAYS OFF IN PHILADELPHIA**



Our pro-life activist colleagues in NE Philadelphia reported on December 18 that, based on personal observations, Stephen Brigham's "Integrity Family Health" was totally closed. A planned demonstration by pro-lifers was cancelled.

The PA Department of Health granted IFH a license to commit abortions despite their August 2010 order against Stephen Brigham having any relationship with an abortion chamber in PA. On November 29, 2013, the DOH ordered IFH to stop committing abortions as of November 29, 2013. However, IFH remained open for abortion referrals and other "women's services." Plus, IFH was taking abortion appointments for December 18, 2013.

Thanks to vigilance from pro-life activists, including Mary Lou Gartner, who alerted the folks in Harrisburg, and extra scrutiny from the PA DOH, abortion business was NIL and the rest of the business was not profitable; therefore, they closed.
