On December 27th we said farewell to Marge Wallace, a long time PCUC member and supporter. The Mother of 11 children (and grandmother of 41), Marge was a part of PCUC before 1973 --

when it was called WOMEN Concerned for the Unborn Child! In addition to living out her pro-life commitment within her family, Marge housed single moms who needed shelter during their pregnancies, and children from a local home who had no place to go for Christmas. She worked with Vietnamese refugees and began the Pittsburgh Community Food Bank with Joyce Rothermel and others at Our Lady of Grace Parish. Wallace was the first female head of a St. Vincent DePaul Chapter in Pittsburgh, working to lift the needy out of poverty. She lived the Gospel of Life on a daily basis. Perhaps best of all, Marge Wallace's legacy at PCUC lives on through her daughters who are now active in the Pittsburgh prolife community: Chris Caprio, Annie Slowey, Claire Kist. Beth Pohlod, and Jeannie French. No. doubt, our gracious Lord welcomed her with open arms at her passing. Well done, good and faithful servant!

JOHN STANTON, R.I.P. – HERO



John **Patrick** Stanton, of Jenkintown, PA, died January 2014. John was the beloved husband of Harriet Marie (nee Althouse). He was Father children: 12 grandchildren; and 15 great grandchildren.

John was the face of the pro-life movement in SE PA. His gentle but straightforward approach to elected officials in Harrisburg could teach a lesson, change a heart or correct a misunderstanding.

Until the week he died, John worked on issues concerning the unborn and mothers with unplanned pregnancies. He founded the Pro-Life Coalition of Southeast Pennsylvania and later established a statewide organization, the Pro-Life Federation.

John was a cofounder of the Pro-Life Educational Foundation, and simultaneously served as treasurer for the Pennsylvania branch of the National Right to Life Committee.

For 10 years ending in 2007, John served as acting director of the Pro-Life Union of Southeast Pennsylvania.

Rain or shine, he prayed and demonstrated outside abortion clinics in the Philadelphia area three times a week for 30 years. His activities resulted in arrests, lawsuits, and a three-month incarceration in the 1990s, his family said in a tribute.

FACTS FROM PP's ANNUAL REPORT

Sometimes when people read reports from prolife sources they scratch

their heads and say, "How can this be when Planned Parenthood tells us they do so much that is good?"

The following is from the "horse's mouth," the PP Annual Report:

- During fiscal year 2011-2012, PP reported receiving \$542 million in taxpayer funding. This \$\$\$ consists of 45% of PP's annual revenue.
- Over the past three reported years, PP has performed nearly one million abortions (995,687)
- PP reported a total of three million clients in 2011, meaning that 11% of all PP clients received an abortion.
- In 2011 abortions made up 92% of PP's pregnancy services. Prenatal care and adoption referrals accounted for only 7% (28,674) and 0.6% (2,300), respectively. For every adoption referral, PP performed 145 abortions.
- Cancer screening & prevention services and contraceptive services provided by PP continue to drop. Contraceptive services have dropped by 12% since 2009, and cancer screening & preventive services have dropped by 29%. Source: Susan B. Anthony Fact Sheet

RUSSIA BANS ABORTION ADVERTISING



In January Russian President Vladimir Putin signed a law banning all abortion advertising. Some members of the Duma (the

Russian state assembly), are talking about going even further and banning the procedure itself. The Russian Orthodox Church, is weighing in as well. One Orthodox prelate called abortion a "mutiny against God."

This is an amazing turnabout in a country which is known for its tragically high abortion rate. Until recently, the average woman in Russia could expect to have seven abortions over her lifetime. Even **The New York Times**, no bastion of pro-life sentiment, has been compelled to acknowledge that Russia's high abortion rate was damaging the health and fertility of Russian women. Not to mention the toll that abortion has taken on the unborn, and on the population as a whole.

It was Lenin who legalized abortion up to birth without any restrictions. The Communist goal was to destroy the family by encouraging women to get abortions, get out of the home and into the workforce.

In the U.S., it was seven members of our Supreme Court who said babies are not people.

It was the early Bolsheviks who developed the suction abortion machine that is still in use in abortion clinics today.

ABORTION PROMOTING BLOG ERASED

For years, the abortion movement has been setting up so-called "safe abortion hotlines" in Latin American countries. They secretly (and illegally) advertise them on the internet. In Peru, the offensive website was under the domain of Blogspot, and it relentlessly promoted abortion. Women who visited the site were given encouragement to break the law and to perform a dangerous and illegal chemical abortion on themselves by obtaining and ingesting Misoprostol from a local pharmacy.

Recently PRI (Population Research Institute) launched a campaign against the website. As a result, hundreds of Peruvian citizens filed complaints with Blogspot to shut down the website. After hesitating for some months, Blogspot finally acted. It shut down the site on the grounds that it was violating Blogspot policy by promoting drugs, in this case an illegal drug. If you type in the site's one-time address at http://lineabortoinfosegura.blogspot.com/, what comes up is a message that this "Blog has been removed."

IS IT "TRIVIA" OR TOUGH TRUTH?



Once in a while we hear about twins who were born before and after midnight; thus on different days. But might the rare event of twins being born on two different months provide more than just trivia?

Consider Maria Jones Elliot who, pregnant with twins in 2012,

went into preterm labor and gave birth to her daughter, Amy, 23 weeks into pregnancy. Amy was a tiny 1 pound 3 ounces and was immediately whisked off to NICU in order to save her life. Unexpectedly, contractions stopped and Amy's twin sister, Katie, decided she wasn't ready to be born! While tiny Amy fought to survive, her twin sister was doing very well in Maria's womb where she continued to mature and grow. Eighty-seven days later Katie was born with a clean bill of health! These beautiful twin sisters are recognized by the Guinness Book of World Records as twins with the most days between births.

Set aside the feel-good elements of the story, and consider for a moment the status of these sisters under the law in America. While Amy was recognized as a human being whose life was protected and worth fighting for, in most states her twin sister would be considered a mere fetus with no rights-a potential victim of abortion.

Here we see plainly the ruthless arbitrariness of abortion: one twin could legally be killed but the other is protected by law. Is location so determinative? This common-sense example is indicative of how laws that leave any unborn child unprotected are discriminatory and assume a fanciful and contrived essential difference between living human beings.

ARCHDIOCESE TAKES BOLD STAND

The Catholic Archdiocese of New Orleans is taking a stand against a new Planned Parenthood clinic, pledging not do business with any individual or business participating in the construction or opening of the facility. Other cities take note.

"The archdiocese will not enter into business relationships with any person or organization that participates in actions that are essential to making this abortion facility a reality," Archbishop Gregory M. Aymond wrote in a Feb. 1 open letter published in the Catholic newspaper **The Clarion-Herald.**

Archbishop Aymond told Newsmax. "While some can disconnect faith from their actions, can a Christian really say they are supporting life if they are in any way participating in the building of a Planned Parenthood facility?

"We are not doing a boycott. We feel this is a way to raise consciousness among the community. Nor is it a threat. We are simply telling people and businesses that we would not be able to do business with them in the future."

GET GRAPHIC, SAYS CBR CHIEF



While he was a two-term Member of The PA House of Representatives, Greg Cunningham introduced legislation which ended public funding for abortion. He and Steve Friend were prime sponsors of the Abortion Control Act which was

litigated before the U.S. Supreme Court in *Thornburgh v. The American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology*. He helped end public funding for abortion in Colorado, and he served in the Reagan administration.

Today as executive director of the Center for Bio-Ethical Reform, Greg has taken on the boldest and least "popular," but the most important life-saving work of his career. The CBR posts the graphic photos of aborted babies that we see at the March for Life. CBR sends out the box trucks with the photos of babies dismembered by forceps, curettes and embryotomy scissors.

We might wonder why a man who had a successful career in law and public service would take on a task to which even some pro-lifers object. Has he "gone too far?" or has he seen tiny human beings treated as less than human, as William Wilberforce did when he crusaded to end the slave trade?" Or does he follow Fr. Frank Pavone, who says, "America will end abortion when America **sees** abortion." It's something for all of us to think about.




