FREEDOM OF SPEECH



On June 26, the U.S. Supreme Court ruled that putting up "buffer zones" around abortion "clinics" is a **violation of the First Amendment.** Written by Justice John Roberts, *McCullen v. Coakley* was an immediate victory for prolife groups.

At this time, Alliance Defending Freedom is considering a challenge to the Pittsburgh "yellow arc" in front of the entrance to Planned Parenthood. Pro-lifers who pray and offer assistance to women entering PP comply with the ordinance. Some pedestrians whisper, "God bless you." Others spout abusive phrases. Most pretend that we are invisible and unworthy of their glance. All of them keep walking.

We wonder if the killing on Liberty Avenue were done because of the victim's disability, or the color of their skin, or national origin, would the attitude of the man on the street be different? As it is, small human beings are being scraped or sucked or dismembered merely because to **one** person they are **inconvenient**.

TWINS ABORTED AT NINE MONTHS

Steven Ertelt at LifeNews related the story of a lady in China, Mrs. Dong, who was pregnant with twin babies (unplanned!) for almost nine months. Her pregnancy was discovered by the local family-planning office. Mrs. Dong was taken to the local health center. With no agreement or signature, she was held by more than ten people and injected with Ethacridine Lactate. The babies struggled for a long time and they died.

Fr. Benedict J. Groeschel, C.F.R., died Saturday, October 4, after an extended illness. He was a renowned retreat director, author, lecturer, teacher, counselor and guide to many, and one of the most well-known and beloved priests in the United States. He was a seminary professor of pastoral

psychology and one of the founders of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal. His advocacy for the unborn will inspire all pro-lifers for generations to come.

LOVING RESPONSE TO BRITTANY



Our friends, Mandy & Dave Capan remind us that their spiritual son, Philip, and Brittany Maynard, the young woman from Washington who plans to kill herself because she has brain cancer, have a lot in common. Since 2008, when he was in the Navy in the Northern Arabian Gulf, he has known he has incurable brain

cancer. Philip's plan for this spring is to be ordained to the transitional diaconate and to the priesthood in 2016.

Brittany is spending what she believes are her last days fundraising and lobbying for an outfit whose goal is to make suicide legal and acceptable—everywhere. They change their name as often as some sects change the date of the end of the world.

Brittany's family is going along with her plot to kill herself. Whatever happened to giving support and HOPE to a loved one in perilous circumstances?

"Suffering is not worthless, and our lives are not our own to take. We do not seek pain for its own sake, but our suffering can have great meaning if we try to join it to the Passion of Christ and offer it for the conversion or intentions of others. While often terrifying, the suffering and pain that we will all experience in our lives can be turned into something positive. This has been a very difficult task for me, but it is possible to achieve," said Philip.

We are presently working on next year's banquet and our goal is to make it even more dynamic.

Second, I invite you to join together and pray and become immersed in Jesus. A pro-life weekend retreat is being planned for February. If you are interested please call the office.

PCUC continues its tradition of taking the truth of abortion to the general public. Wouldn't it be exhilarating to mark 2015 as the year we brought the story of creation and life to the children of our communities? Schools and youth groups are our stage. We can show the excellence, heart and dynamic programming of the pro-life movement. Young people need to understand the humanity of the unborn child. We can teach them. Education touches the minds and souls of people who hear the pro-life message.

We are fighting a terrible evil monster with a long greedy arm. Just consider the following:

Katha Pollitt, author, essayist and columnist of the *The Nation* said "We need to see abortion as an urgent practical decision that is just as moral as the decision to have a child—indeed, sometime more moral." She believes young girls should not have to feel guilty after their abortion. Pollitt works toward this goal.

The *New York Times* reported that Planned Parenthood is breaking ground in the Borough of Queens to build a \$9 million "health" center. They expect to eventually handle 17,500 clients a year. They secured \$250,000 from the state and Queens Borough allocated \$737,000 from their budget. Corporate and private donations total \$8 million. Part of the budget will be for programming. Their target audience: **teenagers**.

Ryan Bomberger of *The Radiance Foundation* reported that U.S. District Judge John E. Jones trashed Pennsylvania's Defense of Marriage Act declaring: "We are a better people than what these laws represent, and it is time to discard them into the ash heap of history. Supporting the only form of marriage that can produce a child—produce a society—is an anachronistic notion that should be torched."

God is our good protector. We know who the winners are but we remain runners of the great race.

The Pro-life movement in Pittsburgh is alive and active: Praying, saving babies, helping moms, accomplishing good and winning political races. There is no doubt Pittsburgh pro-lifers will continue. After all, People Concerned for the Unborn Child has been here

since 1969 and for many years was the only pro-life voice in Pittsburgh. Now there are many others who honor God's call to be faithful. To continue this call I believe we need to produce a strong, entertaining and moral program that will reach out to our young.
