ABORTED BABIES IN JANITOR'S CLOSET



Pennsylvania officials recently discovered unsafe and unsanitary conditions in two Planned Parenthood abortion facilities.

Inspectors found “dark stains” and improperly sanitized equipment at PP's

Far Northeast and Locust Street Health Centers.

According to the report, they discovered that both facilities were not properly sterilizing some of their equipment. They also found that sterile packaging had been removed from unused syringes and needles, and cleaning brushes were not being regularly sterilized.

At the Far East location, unfrozen remains were stored in a janitor's closet. At the Locust St. facility inspectors found aborted babies' remains in bags that were undated, which made it impossible to verify if the aborted babies' bodies were being disposed of as required by state law.

Both facilities were already on probation due to a failure to report sexual assaults on underage girls.

SADLY, BIRTHS ARE STILL LIMITED



The Chinese government is apparently ready to loosen the stranglehold it has had on reproduction in that country since the late seventies—a little bit. Under the new policy, married Chinese couples will be allowed not one, but two children. As we learn more, we see that permission for a second child is limited to couples who get it in writing, and a third child must be aborted. Women must still report their cycles to the local authorities.

"The regime is backing away from draconian birth limits," says Steven Mosher, President of the Population Research Institute, "not because senior Party officials have suddenly developed a conscience. Rather, it will be because they have finally realized that a shrinking workforce and a rapidly aging population are crippling future economic growth."

SURROGATE REFUSES ABORTION



Surrogate carrier Brittneyrose Torres is being pressured to abort at least one of the triplets she is carrying for a couple from the south. Brittany told The New York Post that the “birth parents” (sic)

"knew from the beginning that we wouldn't want to abort unless it was a life-and-death situation."

Torres was implanted with two embryos in hopes that one of them would develop. Not only did both survive, but twinning occurred, giving Torres one girl and twin boys.

Initially excited about triplets, the parental contractors later claimed increased risk of developmental disabilities and demanded that Torres abort the girl.

"I told her I couldn't abort one of the children. It will be killing this baby." She offered to adopt the girl, but the parental contractors refused.

Torres's decision to choose life for the triplets she was asked to carry for another couple speaks volumes to what is wrong with reproductive technology. The signed contract included a provision giving both parental contractors the legal right to order an abortion. Now the parental contractors are withholding payments until Brittneyrose aborts a baby.

"I want other women not to be put in this situation. They shouldn't be forced to do something they don't want to," said Brittneyrose.

HORROR STORIES FROM AFRICA



Human Life International (HLI) investigated horror stories from Tanzania and Uganda about poor women forced to insert dangerous contraceptive & abortifacient drugs and devices into their

Frank will speak at a luncheon for pro-lifers. We will invite clergy of all denominations, especially those whose parishes are part of the 40 Days for Life prayer vigil.
