LETTER FROM THE PREZ

Dear Pro-life friends,

Hold on just one minute. Put those dancing shoes back in the box and get the work boots back out of the closet. Of course we're glad the election turned out as it did: pro-life president, pro-life senate, pro-life House. And in Pennsylvania, we retained a lot of great pro-life representatives and senators.

But let's look a little closer at the vote and a little closer to home. PCUC is centered in the South Hills of Pittsburgh, in Allegheny County. And in Allegheny County, the pro-life candidate lost by 100,000 votes. Think about it. One hundred thousand of your co-workers, neighbors, church members, in-laws and out-laws voted for the most radical pro-abortion candidate this country has ever seen. This woman was comfortable with providing tax-payer money for abortions right before birth, for any reason or no reason at all. One hundred thousand people ignored or didn't know that and she got their vote.

So we pro-lifers have the biggest opportunity and the biggest challenge of recent times. How do we change minds, hearts, and voting of those who said "okay" to a political party that had planned (see Democratic Platform p. 37) to oppose and remove all restrictions on abortion? Basically, the Democratic Party which controls Pittsburgh and Allegheny County was quite open about backing institutions and non-profits like Planned Parenthood and Allegheny Reproductive who make obscene amounts of money by killing preborn children. We saw in the Post Gazette social scene column that not too long ago, County Executive Rich Fitzgerald went to the Planned Parenthood "War on Women" exhibit. And people voted for that.

What to do? Do what works. PCUC is the umbrella organization funding various movements within the pro-life arena and we back what works. We can see it happening during every 40 Days for Life campaign, through the weekly witness of Side Walk Advocates for Life standing outside Planned Parenthood, the March for Life, Life Chain and other groups that operate through colleges and beneficial organizations.

And what do they do that works? That's easy. Prayer, fasting, witnessing--to borrow from 40 Days for Life. Does anyone doubt the power of prayer now that the election results have arrived? Pro-lifers delivered an astonishing amount of votes with volunteers knocking on doors, little money and lots of prayer. How else can these victories be explained?

Fast from whatever makes you doubt our cause: mainstream media, local newspapers, Hollywood and its pro-death agenda, food we don't need or shouldn't eat. Fast to make you aware that it's time to pray. Witnessing is hard/easy. Just mention the humanity of a pre-born child when your co-worker shows a new sonogram picture. Take a vacation day for the March for Life and then tell your friends why it's important to do so. Stand in front of Planned Parenthood and quietly pray. Offer literature with help for any woman or man thinking that abortion IS THE ANSWER WHEN IT'S A SYMPTOM OF A BIGGER PROBLEM. If you need such literature, call us, we'll send it to you ASAP. Who knows? That pregnancy resource card that you leave in Eat N' Park just might make its way into the hands of a pregnant teenager. More people in America voted for a pro-abortion candidate. We have our work cut out for us. Let's just keep going.
