#### UNITED WAY SUPPORTS PP

Despite an expose' in recent years that the Planned Parenthood business sells the body parts of aborted babies, and despite the fact that PP is the nation's biggest abortion company, a new report indicates that United Way affiliates fund it with millions of donations.

Late in August, 2<sup>nd</sup>Vote, the conservative watchdog for corporate activism, released its annual findings on United Way's financial support for PP. The report tracks 1200 United Way affiliates.

Analysis of the most recent IRS Form 990 filings and other documentation found 62 UW affiliates sent \$2,756,799.00 to PP abortion organizations in tax year 2016.

2<sup>nd</sup> Vote Executive Director Robert Kuykendall said, "Our research...gives conservatives and pro-life activists a resource to make sure their charitable donations won't be used to support PP's abortion business. ### STATISTICS TELL A SAD STORY

National Right to Life Committee (NRLC) released its 5<sup>th</sup> annual report on the state of abortion in the U.S. Highlights include:

- Based on data from the Guttmacher Institute and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and projecting 2014 figures for subsequent years (2015-2017), NRLC estimates 60,069,971 abortions have been performed in the U.S. since 1973.
- Planned Parenthood, which reported nearly \$1.5 billion in revenue in 2017-2018, and posted nearly \$100 million in profit, is estimated to have made nearly \$160 million performing 321,384 abortions—over one-third of all abortions annually.
