#### ALLEGHENY COUNTY COUNCIL SENDS PROCLAMATION

Sue Means, member of the Allegheny County Office of County Council, delivered the following: "A Proclamation honoring People Concerned for the Unborn Child's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary...

Whereas, People Concerned for the Unborn Child (PCUC) is a volunteer-led organization in the Brookline neighborhood of the City of Pittsburgh that is dedicated to acting on behalf of all innocent life threatened by abortion, infanticide and euthanasia; and Whereas, founded in 1969 in the kitchen of Mary Winter, PCUC works tirelessly to affirm that the unborn child is a human being entitled to the same rights as all other Americans. and Whereas, over the past 50 years, PCUC has been devoted to educating and raising awareness among the citizens of Allegheny County about the right to life through their newsletter, hosting prayer vigials, and providing support for expectant mothers and infants in need; and Whereas, every January, PCUC travels on their own time and at their own expense to Washington, DC, to protest the Supreme Court's decision, Roe v. Wade. By participating in the March for Life. PCUC is hopeful that the decision will be overturned and other trips to the United States Capitol will be unnecessary; NOW, therefore be it resolved, that we, Allegheny County Council Members Sue Means, Pat Catena, and Sam DeMarco, do hereby congratulate People Concerned for the Unborn Child upon the occasion of its  $50^{th}$  Anniversary, and we thank them for their continued dedication to acting on behalf of all innocent life.

#### SCHOOL NURSE SECRETLY IMPLANTS BIRTH CONTROL IN 16-YR OLD

Mom could not understand why her daughter was complaining of headaches and pain in her arm. When a pediatrican checked her out he told the mom that the three-year contraceptive, Nexplanon, had been improperly implanted in her daughter's arm and it must be removed.

According to paperwork on Merck's website, the maker of Nexplanon, the implant should go on the inside of the upper arm. The daughter had the implant near the back of her arm. The mother cried, just to hear that such a thing could happen to her child, and parents don't even know what's going on.

#### DALEIDEN TRIAL EXPOSES EVIL

Deborah Nucatola, abortionist and former Medical Director for Planned Parenthood Federation of America, told the courtroom in the federal trial against David Daleidien and pro-life activists in the RICO (Racketeer Influenced Corrupt Organizations Act) that had been conducting on average 200 abortions per month for her entire 21-year career. It means she has been responsible for deaths of over 50,000 preborn babies.

Upon cross examination one pro-life attorney asked Nucatola about the damages caused by the video. In earlier deposition Nucatola said the release of the videos was "no big deal," that "did not damage me." Later, she sobbed when relating how she and her family were "damaged" by them. The contradiction completely impeached her testimony and destroyed her credibility.

Then Judge William Orrick allowed the playing of five minutes of raw, uncut video from the lunch meeting between Nucatola and the pro-life journalists who posed as representatives of an organ procurement company.

The jury was stunned as Nucatola spoke about lungs, livers, hearts and baby heads harvested for sale. At that moment, the game changed. PP's star witness became a witness for the defense.
