### **CHINA HARVESTING ORGANS**

Steven Mosher, president of the Population Research Institute, has called on the Vatican,



specifically Archbishop Sorondo, head of the Pontifical Academy of Sciences, to speak out against China's killing of prisoners for their organs.

Mosher told **LifeSiteNews** that the Chinese government is harvesting organs from countless prisoners while they are still alive to supply its lucrative organ transplant industry. China has moved to a "more advanced" version of its decades-long practice of executing prisoners.

They are now paralyzing prisoners in order to extract their organs while they are still alive. These organs are placed in cold-packs, sold for tens of thousands of dollars, and taken to operating rooms where they can be transplanted. Mosher noted that the United States has called for an investigation into this horrific practice.

#### LEGALIZED ABORTION NOW IN IRELAND



A total of 6,666 abortions were per-formed in Ireland in the first year after repeal of the country's prolife Eighth Amendment, according to official figures just released. In its first

annual report since the liberalization of abortion laws, Ireland's Department of Health said June 30 that 6,542 of the abortions carried out in 2019 took place during "early pregnancy."

Maeve O'Hanlon, spokesperson for the Pro-Life Campaign, said, "Those adopting an attitude to the latest figures of 'nothing to see here, everything is fine and going to plan' are downplaying the loss of life caused by the recent introduction of abortion here, as evidenced in today's numbers."

### ABORTION STILL ILLEGAL IN MEXICO



Mexico's Supreme Court shocked pro-abortion and feminist activists and handed to pro-life forces what many see as a decisive victory, ruling against

a lower court injunction seeking to decriminalize abortion in the Mexican state of Veracruz.

Abortion activists hoped to use the injunction as a template to expand abortion across the country. Currently, abortion is legal in only two of Mexico's 32 states.

### **LESKO DEMANDS PP RETURN \$\$**

On July 27, Congresswoman Debbie Lesko (R-Ariz.) introduced the Paycheck Protection Integrity Act. The legislation requires Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PPFA) and its affiliates to return funds they received through the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) that is administered by the Small Business Administration (SBA).

Though it was not supposed to, the Planned Parenthood abortion business improperly applied for and received \$80 million in federal funds meant to support small businesses as they battle the economic fallout from the corona virus. Leading pro-life groups support the bill.

### PP ASHAMED OF SANGER'S NAME

They denied it since she founded the baby-killing industry in 1916, but now Planned Parenthood of New York has plans to remove Margaret Sanger's name from the Manhattan office. It has also asked city leaders to remove her name from a street sign nearby. Sanger was a well-known eugenicist who believed certain groups of human beings were "weeds," "reckless breeders" and "morons" who should not have children.

### PP's NEW APP DESIGNED TO SNEAK AROUND PARENTS

American Life League's executive director warns parents that a new chat-driven smartphone app created by Planned Parenthood is designed to sneak around parents and get PP into the hands of teenagers. "It's their way to get around (the parents) to get directly to the kids...especially when the kids are not going to school, where they are at home, getting bored and looking for things on their cell phones to pass the time of day. ### TRUMP NAMES ETHICS ADVISORY BOARD

Scientists and bioethics experts who believe babies in the womb deserve basic human rights are leaders in a new advisory board investigating the use of aborted baby body parts in government-funded research.

The Trump administration established the National Institutes of Health NIH) Human Fetal Tissue Research Ethics Advisory Board amid calls to end the practice of using aborted baby body parts in taxpayer-funded research. President Trump appointed the members. At least 10 of them are pro-life.

Members include Paige Comstock Cunningham, former leader of Americans United for Life and Dr. David A. Prentice, research director at the Charlotte Lozier Institute. Other members include Ingrid Skop, an OB-GYN, and Greg Burke of the Catholic Medical Association ethics committee.

The board's task is to make a report for Health and Human Services Secretary Alex Azar.

One member, Lawrence Goldstein, used aborted baby body parts in research on Alzheimer's disease. Four other members have not made public statements about the issue.
