JUDGE BLOCKS HEARTBEAT BILL

On Wednesday, Oct. 6, a federal judge bloacked enforcement of the pro-life Heartbeat Act in Texas. The law is estimaated to have saved over 5,000 babies' lives in just over a month. The decision followed the Biden administration's lawsuit.

Under provisions of Texas S.B., known as the Texas Heartbeat Act, abortions are prohibited upon the detection of an unborn

baby's heartbeat. The law also allowed private citizens to sue abortionists who perform abortions after a heartbeat can be perceived.

Jonathan Saena, President of Texas Values described Judge Pitman's ruling as "all politics and no law."

Texas Right to Life said Pitman's ruling is a "wildly broad" and "astonishing" move, motivated by "extreme prejudice."

Texas lawyers indicated they would appeal to the Fifth Circuit Court of appeals.


