Joan Derrick was a member of the local Le Leche League. It was there she became friends with another mom, Mary Winter. Joan had a household of six lively boys and one girl. Howard, her beloved husband, was a craftsman in tile. Joan made friends easily, and she

never forgot a name or an adventure. She was a big help to her pastor, too.

When Joey was born with Down syndrome, he became her pride and joy, her constant companion. He helped around the house by feeding the pets and helping with chores. He was an outstanding employee of Giant Eagle

In 1969, some wise women saw the changes coming via the "women's liberation movement" and Planned Parenthood. They responded with truth, facts and Birthright, a source of medical, social and practical help for moms and babies.

Meanwhile, Joan learned to use a computer. She kept track of people, pro-life doctors and pro-life news from around the country and the world. She was one of the seven founders of Women Concerned for the Unborn Child, which later became PCUC.

For 53 years, Joan was the center of our office for membership, mailings to thousands of members. LIFEPAK, 40 Days for Life, and March for Life packets got her full attention. She and Joe took them all to the Post Office on the Northside. She designed our Christmas cards, kept track of donations, paid bills, purchased office equipment and hosted our annual Christmas party.

This year our party was a pleasant but subdued gathering, but we knew Joan wanted us to have it. We are sad to say that after several weeks of fighting covid, Joan went home to her heavenly Father on Friday, November 26.

## MARCH FOR LIFE


**Don't miss your 2022 opportunity to participate in the annual dawn to dusk March for Life to Washington, DC, on Friday, January 21.**

### **HONOR LILLIAN WITH PRAYER**

High on our list of Honors and Memories for January-February 2022 is a Greatly-appreciated “Thanksgiving for PCUC from Lillian Rausch.

In return, we urge everyone to pray for Lillian Rausch. Lillian came downtown when the first abortion mill opened on Good Friday, 1973. From that day forward, it was Lillian (and her pal, Vince Bruno) who, several days every week, stood on the sidewalk outside Pittsburgh’s first abortion facility, prayed, and offered leaflets with information for assistance to every woman headed for “Women’s Health Service” on Stanwix Street.

Until just a few months ago, Lillian was still praying near the doors of Planned Parenthood. She came downtown on a bus from the North Side, despite problems with blindness.

Lillian, we love you and pray for you.

### **THANK YOU, 40 DAYS FOR LIFE**

We might even call it, “40 DAYS FOR LOVE” because it is love for God’s tiniest, most help-less children that brings us to the sidewalk in front of Planned Parenthood for 12 hours a day for 40 Days to pray and show the people of Pittsburgh that we care.

We thank Nikki Bruni, not only for her fine leadership of 40 Days for Life in our city but for showing pro-life volunteers in Croatia how we do it in Pittsburgh AND for being named *40 Days for Life Leader of the Year* at the Annual Summer Symposium in Houston this August.

Pittsburgh’s next *40 Days for Life* will start on March 2, which is Ash Wednesday, but it’s not too early to plan to be part of this life-loving, life-saving vigil of prayer.

### **DANGEROUS RETREAD**

Pres. Joe Biden has nominated a former head of the federal Food & Drug Administration to come back and head the agency.

It was under the administration of Robert Califf in 2016 that the FDA “enabled several modifications to a safety requirement for the abortion pill.” Those modifications included changes in the dosage, in the means of administration and a change in the interval between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> drug in the two-drug cocktail. Under Califf’s leadership, the FDA also allowed aborting mothers to take the abortion pills at home or wherever they wish, rather than requiring the chemicals to be administered in the abortion shop where they were dispensed.

Critically, the changes also lengthened the time frame when the abortion drug can be taken. When first approved for sale in the US, its dispensing was limited to the first seven weeks of a baby’s gestation. Under Mr. Califf, the FDA extended that time to ten weeks.

If these changes in the way a baby is disposed of by a pill that might have been sitting in someone’s purse for a few weeks, please call your home-state Senators and ask for a “NO” vote on any motion leading to the confirmation of Robert Califf to head the FDA. ### **CATHOLIC LEAGUE CALLS FOR INVESTIGATION AT U. OF PGH.**

Catholic League president Bill Donohue contacted PA Auditor General Timothy L. DeFoor about allegations that researchers at the U. of Pittsburgh are harvesting the organs of unborn babies.

### **PELOSI & CO. LOOK TO REPEAL HYDE BEFORE 2022 MIDTERMS**

House and Senate Democrats are looking for ways to repeal the Hyde Amendment before the 2022 midterm elections—a move that would permit the federal government to directly fund abortion-related services. The House budget bill, which violates the Hyde Amendment, is unlikely to survive a 60-vote filibuster in the U. S. ### **PRO-LIFE BRITISH LAWMAKER MURDERED**

A British lawmaker died last month after suffering multiple stab wounds while at a meeting with constituents at a Methodist Church in southeast England. Sir David Amess, 69, was a Member of Parliament since 1983 and a member of the Conservative party. He was a Catholic and pro-life. Amess' recent voting records showed that he voted against the legalization of assisted suicide, in favor of stricter gestational limits on abortions, and against the imposition of abortion on Northern Ireland, among other pro-life measures. Twenty-five year old Ali Harbi, affiliated to Islamic State, has been arrested in connection with the killing, and a knife has been recovered.

Cardinal Vincent Nichols of Westminster released a statement paying tribute to Amess and urging prayers for him and his family.

Prime Minister Boris Johnson said Amess had an "outstanding record of passing laws to help the most vulnerable." Right to Life UK described Amess as a "pro-life champion."
