LIFE in the WOMB

3 Weeks

(after conception)

The heart is pumping blood and the eyes, ears and nose start to develop.

4 Weeks

Foundations of the brain, spinal cord and nervous system are already established. The basic structures of the baby have begun to develop.

8 Weeks

Brain waves can be detected and PAIN can be felt. Teeth and taste buds form. The baby sometimes hiccups and is about 1 ½ inch long. Fingers & toes are developing.



12 Weeks

Fingerprints are evident & never change. The baby is now about 2 inches long, sleeps & is very active. The heartbeat may be heard by ultrasound and the gender can be determined. All the body systems are working.



16 Weeks

The baby is about 8 inches long and weighs about ½ pound. The eyes blink; facial features are distinct & fingers & toes are clearly developed. The baby hears the mom's heartbeat and external music.
