## MEDICATION ABORTIONS ON THE RISE



Medication abortions have grown from roughly 6% of abortions in 2001 to over half of all abortions in 2020, and that percentage is likely higher now. Medication abortions are tougher to track and regulate, particularly if prescribed by telemedicine or delivered by mail.

Medication abortions are painful and accompanied by adverse reactions 85% of the time. Women lose more blood through chemical abortions than surgical ones, and life-threatening hemorrhaging may require surgical treatment. The FDA warns these drugs fail to deliver a complete abortion 2-7% of the time.

## **FL MAN CHARGED WITH 2 MURDERS IN KILLING GIRLFRIEND WHO REFUSED ABORTION**

Police in Florida, charged a 21-year-old-man with double homicide in the killing of his pregnant girlfriend and preborn child, an action police say was motivated by her refusal to get an abortion.

Donovan Faison was charged with two counts of homicide: one for the death of Kaylin Fiengo and the other for the death of her preborn child, with whom she had been pregnant for about 12 weeks. Police said she died from an apparent gunshot wound as she sat in the vehicle.

## **FRANCISCAN FRIAR GETS 6 MO. IN JAIL FOR BLOCKING NYC ABORTION CLINIC ENTRANCE**

Catholic priest and pro-life activist Fr. Fidelis Moscinski was sentenced to six months in federal prison for blocking access to a Planned Parenthood abortion facility by placing locks and chains on the gated entrance. Six months is the maximum available for this crime. Moscinski was found guilty of violating the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances (FACE) Act, which imposes harsh penalties for obstructing access to an abortion facility or a pregnancy center.

"My actions...were done because Planned Parenthood as an organization is in the business of killing," Moscinski told the judge while asking for a lenient sentence.

Although the priest is a member of Red Rose Rescue, the organization has emphasized that his effort to block access to an abortion clinic was not sanctioned by the group. Red Rose said members can engage in pro-life activism outside of their organization, but they are a sole agent when doing so.

## **LAWS CAN DO WONDERS WHEN ENFORCED**

An Orlando abortuary may have crossed a final line in its habitual flaunting of Florida's law providing a 24-hour waiting period for mothers seeking abortion. What else would you call the 193 violations? This since the 2015 law became enforceable in 2022 when finally released by the courts. According to the *LifeSiteNews* report by Matt Lamb, citing *CBS News* as source, the states' Agency for Health Care Administration "'alleged that 193 abortions were performed at the facility from April 26, 2022, to May 7, 2022, without 24-hour waiting periods...State law allows the agency to collect a maximum of \$1,000 for each violation of the law.'"

Orlando's American Family Planning facility is affiliated with disgraced abortionist Stephen Chase Brigham. If the maximum fine is levied, it could mean permanent closure. The facility has 30 days to pay up. *Life Advocacy Briefing* 8/21/23



**PRO-LIFE ACTIVISTS FOUND  
GUILTY OF OBSTRUCTING  
ABORTION ACCESS IN DC**

Five pro-life advocates who entered a Washington, DC, abortion facility as part of a “rescue” in October 2020 were convicted of felony charges Tuesday afternoon, a ruling that at least one activist plans to appeal.

All five defendants were convicted of felony conspiracy against rights and felony violation of the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances (FACE) Act. Each could face up to 11 years in prison and a fine up to \$350,000.

The FACE Act, signed into law by Pres. Clinton, prohibits individuals from obstructing women seeking abortions and destruction or defacement of clinics themselves.

In addition to Handy, 67-year-old John Hinshaw, 61-year-old Heather Idoni, 52-year-old William Goodman, and 25-year-old Herb Geraghty were convicted.

According to the DOJ, four of the five activists “forcefully entered the clinic and blockaded two doors using their bodies, furniture, chains and ropes.” The activities were livestreamed.

Handy testified in court that she viewed an undercover video of the facility released by the pro-life group Live Action that she believed showed abortionists refusing to offer care to a child who survived an abortion attempt. Her lawyers argued that Handy was not trying to halt reproductive health care but was instead motivated by her belief that illegal activities were taking place at the facility.

All five defendants were immediately incarcerated, though sentencing has yet to take place. The defendants “were led out of the courtroom by an army of U.S. Marshalls. Steve Crampton, a senior counsel at The Thomas More Society, said, “This is an outrage, and the one thing the defendants had really agreed upon was to remain nonviolent. The real violence is what happens during the abortion procedure.”
