One of the best things about being part of a good organization is that we never stand still. I wasn't around when PCUC started as WCUC. I didn't even know it existed until I got

involved in 1972. Thank God for Mary Winter, Rita Cunningham, Joan Derrick and the other brave, bold women who stepped up to stop abortion in Pittsburgh and everywhere.

One afternoon we all met at Lois' house to talk about a lady named Nellie Gray and how she planned a "March for Life" in Washington, DC, to protest the *Roe v. Wade* decision by the U. S. Supreme Court to legalize abortion. I don't remember all that was said that day, but I thought, "Gee! That's a really big proposition. I hope some people will go."

The following January I was among the 10,000 or so people who "marched" around the Capitol. The people at the end of the line started their "march" as the folks who were at the front were completing their "march." I was four months pregnant, and I heard that Eileen Vogel, one of our leaders, was also "expecting." The thing that made Eileen's planning for the March extraordinary was that on one of her rides to and from DC to plan the March, she spent the night in her car on the Pennsylvania Turnpike.

There's so much more to tell you about being part of the pro-life movement. I should write a book, but for now I'll just say I don't regret any of it. I'll pray for PCUC every day, and I hope you will pray for me.

PITTSBURGH SIDEWALK ADVOCATES & 40 DAYS 365 ARE MAKING A DIFFERENCE!

2023 has been a tumultuous year. The good news is, that we have saved more lives on the Sidewalk, whose mothers had plans to abort them. In the last month alone, we've had a confirmed SAVE where a woman left the table as she was getting prepped for an abortion; a "HOPEFUL" where a Spanish speaking woman was redirected to Little Lamb, where she was counseled by two Sidewalk Advocates and given the Spanish language trifold brochure; and a young couple who came out and said they decided not to take the abortion pill!

I'm also proud to announce we have four newly trained Sidewalk Advocates to add to our numbers! A warm welcome goes to out Jim F., Michele K., Sam L., and Ethan S., who completed a full Saturday training session on December 9. And the good news is, I've seen all four of them for at least one shift downtown on the Sidewalk, working to save the babies!

The bad news is, that Planned Parenthood is now scheduling abortions on Mondays – a 6th day! That means hundreds more babies will potentially be killed before they have a chance to breathe one breath of fresh air on this earth. I bet many of you did not know that every year, according to their own state-reported statistics, over 3000 unborn children are killed every year behind the evil doors of Planned Parenthood. With Mondays now open, it may approach over 3500!

We need your help! If you can't attend the training and volunteer to become a Sidewalk Advocate, or even come to pray while a sidewalk advocate is in need of a partner, *then at least consider a donation to PCUC*. "CONSERVATIVE" ANNE COULTER ATTACKS PRO-LIFE LAW. RICK SANTORUM HAS AN AMAZING RESPONSE:

Columnist Ann Coulter has long had a reputation as a fearless conservative firebrand. Which is why it's so surprising to see her continue to attack prolifers. After pro-lifers lost in Ohio, Coulter responded by saying: "PRO-LIFERS ARE GOING TO WIPE OUT THE REPUBLICAN PARTY."

I had just lost a major court decision, and if it stuck, I'd have been on the hook to pay PP nearly \$500,000 in legal fees.

We ultimately won that case, and I never paid PP a dime. And in the end, that bad ruling actually <u>helped</u> us win the case on appeal.

OXFORD DOCTOR TELLS OF SAFETY OF ABORTION PILL REVERSAL

"An utter farce. Don't listen to them." This is a quote from Dr. Callum Miller's Twitter page. Dr. Miller is a medical doctor and a bioethicist at Oxford University. The "them" he refers to are those who, citing only one study of Abortion Pill Reversal (APR), claim that it is unsafe for the woman. He critiqued this study on LifeNews.com on November 17, 2023.

Dr. Miller's critique is very important, but there is not enough space to include it here. We will only repeat his conclusion: "Opponents of abortion pill reversal choice often say that it is dangerous. Their evidence for this is one single patient who had a very minor hemorrhage (as often happens during a medical abortion) and did not need any treatment at all. An utter farce.

PP DOESN'T MAKE APPOINTMENTS FOR "INDECISION COUNSELING"

PP in Minnesota (and probably in PA) does not make appointments for "indecision counseling" regarding pregnancy. The woman must make an appointment for a pregnancy test or <u>abortion</u>, and counseling would be included if desired. Or the woman can call one of two hotline numbers provided by PP: a hotline run by the national PP office or a hotline run by an abortion-supporting organization called All Options.

The bottom line is that if a woman tells you she is pregnant, but is just at PP for "counseling," assume she is there for an already-scheduled abortion appointment even if, in reality, she is somewhat unsure about her decision (as many women are).

PATIENTS IN PA AND DE SEEK TO CHANGE NJ RESIDENCE LAW

A Pennsylvania resident is seeking to change the aidin-dying law in New Jersey.

If she lived in New Jersey, Andy Seal who was diagnosed with breast cancer, could host a funeral for herself where her family and friends could share their love for her before she takes her own life. But Andy does not live in New Jersey. She lives in Pennsylvania. New Jersey is one of 10 states that allow terminally ill patients to get a lethal dose of drugs to end their lives, but the law prohibits doctors from prescribing these medications to anyone who is not a resident of NJ. Oregon and Vermont have similar laws which first agreed to not allow out of state residents access to aid-in-dying, but these safeguards were later tossed.

Remember: Never has a law, once passed, been limited or overturned. Assisted suicide laws only become more lethal for more people.

IT'S TIME TO DEFEND THE HYDE AMENDMENT

It's time to call on the conservative leadership in Congress to take a bold stand to DEFEND the Hyde Amendment. Since 1976, the Hyde Amendment has protected Americans from having to pay for abortions through our federal tax dollars. Named for pro-life Congressman Henry Hyde (R-Ill), the Amendment was first passed in 1976, three years after the tragic Roe v Wade Supreme Court decision. And Congress has included it in every appropriations bill since. The Hyde Amendment was not an issue until now. If the pro-abortion lobby, their allies in Congress, and the White House have their way, that protection will be cut shortforcing you and me to pay for abortions through our federal tax dollars. In 2020, every Democratic candidate for president went on record for repealing the Hyde Amendment – including now-President Joe Boden, who voted for it as a senator in 1976 but flip-flopped as a candidate for president. President Biden has now repeatedly demonstrated his obsession with abortion, becoming the most proabortion president in U.S. history.
